Four days have been allocated for the hearing of this appeal. This will be heard at the Court of Appeal, Wellington. Three Judges will preside. Please note that all hearings at the Court of Appeal are recorded. It is not the Court's standard practice to transcribe these recordings.

If your case proceeds into the second day a fee of \$1,329.20 is payable for each half day or part thereof after the first day of hearing. You will be invoiced at the end of each half-day or full day of hearing, and this must be settled immediately unless you make other arrangements with the Registrar.

The Appellant's submissions are to be filed on or before Wednesday 14 March 2012 and the Respondent's must be filed on Wednesday 28 March 2012. The due dates for submissions are in accordance with the requirements of the Court of Appeal (Civil) Rules 2005. Submissions must be filed in compliance with the Court of Appeal (Civil) Rules 2005.

Although you now have a fixture date, Rule 43 of the Court of Appeal (Civil) Rules 2005 still applies. Your Case on Appeal, if not already filed, must be received at the Court before the expiry of six months from the date you filed the appeal. Please refer to Rule 40 of the Court of Appeal (Civil) Rules 2005 for detailed information regarding the correct form of the Case on Appeal.



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Also note the requirements of Rule 42A of the Court of Appeal (Civil) Rules 2005 – Issues. The issues list must be provided to the Court no later than Thursday 11 April 2013. Counsel will be given a maximum of 15 minutes at the beginning of their oral submissions to outline their case, covering all of the issues raised by the appeal. Counsel should also deal with any matters arising out of the written submissions of the other side and such of the factual background as is necessary to understand the issues. During this presentation there will be no interruption from the Bench.

The Court must be informed immediately if for any reason you are unable to attend this fixture.
