Amendment

- 1 Title**
This is the Electricity Industry Participation (Revocation of Standard Tariff Codes Requirement) Code Amendment 2013.
- 2 Commencement**
This amendment comes into force on 21 October 2013.
- 3 Code amended**
This amendment amends the Electricity Industry Participation Code 2010.
- 4 Clause 12A.1 amended (Contents of this Part)**
Delete clause 12A.1(f).
- 5 Clause 12A.8 amended (Changes to tariff rates)**
Amend clause 12A.8 as follows:
 - (a) in subclause (1), replace "Clauses 12A.9 and clause 12A.10 apply" with "Clause 12A.9 applies";
 - (b) delete subclause (2).
- 6 Clause 12A.10 revoked (Requirement to use standard tariff codes)**
Revoke clause 12A.10.

Explanatory Note

This note is not part of the amendment, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This amendment to the Electricity Industry Participation Code 2010 comes into force on 21 October 2013.

The amendment revokes the requirement for distributors to use standard tariff codes when changing a tariff rate, including by introducing or removing a tariff rate.
