Lower South Island Renewables Investment Proposal – Final Decision

On 26 April 2010, the Commission issued a notice of its intention to approve Transpower's Lower South Island Renewables Investment Proposal in accordance with rule 15.1 of section III of part F of the Electricity Governance Rules 2003.

Following this, a public conference was held in Alexandra on 28 June 2010, to provide those affected with a further opportunity to comment on the Proposal.

After consideration of submissions, the Commission decided to confirm its decision to approve the Proposal on 9 August 2010.

Amendments to Rules relating to Registry and switching reconciliation and clearing.

The Minister of Energy and Resources recently approved rule amendments to parts A, E, H, and J of the Rules. The effective dates for these amendments are as follows:

Rules 6, 7, 8, 10, and 11 of part H and rules 8, 10, 11, and 12 of part J will come into force on 23 August 2010

All other rule amendments will come into force on 30 September 2010
