Historic lake storage: Report and datasets

A brief history of storage fluctuations in major hydro lakes has been prepared for the Commission by OPUS International. Lakes covered are Ohau, Tekapo, Pukaki, Te Anau, Manapouri, Hawea, Wanaka, Wakatipu, Taupo and Waikaremoana.

The report converts lake levels in metres above sea level, provided in *Lake Level History*, to hydro generation potential (GWh) and was produced with support from Genesis Energy, Mighty River Power, Meridian Energy, and Contact Energy, as well as data from NIWA's National Hydrometric Archive.

The report is accompanied by a dataset of lake storages (GWh) from 1 January 1990 - 1 July 2010. These are based on lake-level data from the Power Archive, maintained by OPUS International under contract to the various generators.
