Following review of Transpower's 2009 annual report on interconnection asset capacity and grid configuration, the Commission proposes an amendment to schedule F6 of the Interconnection Rules by updating the schedule to include the information in the 2009 annual report.

Discussion paper: Security, Web Services, and EIEP Data Exchange

A paper has been published on security risks associated with the way information is exchanged within the electricity industry. Three issues affecting the registry and participant processes are discussed:

- Introducing a registry-secure file-transfer mechanism.
- Provision of Web Services to support data exchange to participants' back-office and customeracquisition systems.
- Facilitating Electricity Information Exchange Protocols (EIEP) data exchange between participants through the use of the registry-secure file-transfer mechanism.

Settlement agreement approved

The Commission has approved a settlement agreement between Genesis Power Ltd, Transpower New Zealand Ltd (as System Operator), Norske Skog Tasman Ltd and Meridian Energy Ltd in respect of an alleged breach of the Rules.

The admitted breach concerned the failure to comply with a dispatch instruction during the commissioning of Huntly Unit 5.

Exemptions from AUFLS Requirements

The Commission intends, under regulation 194(5)(c) of the Electricity Governance Regulations 2003, to extend the exemptions granted to Norske Skog Tasman Limited, Northpower Limited, Winstone Pulp International Limited, Toll New Zealand Limited, Pan Pac Forest Products Limited and New Zealand Steel Limited from compliance with the automatic under-frequency load shedding requirements of rules 6.1, 6.4 and 6.5 of technical code B of schedule C3 of part C of the Electricity Governance Rules 2003.
