Submissions are invited on proposed new rules regarding metering standards, under Part D of the Electricity Governance Rules 2003 (Rules). Details are set out in the consultation paper published at:

Wholesale settlement requires accurate metering and data-handling processes at every point of connection and Part D covers participants' obligations relating to metering installation, testing, and compliance with codes of practice, and the reconciliation manager's role with respect to metering inaccuracies.
