1 **Welcome and Apologies**

- 10. The Chair requested the secretariat to provide a confirmation of the time of the 25 February 2014 meeting to the SRC members.
- 11. The SRC members noted that the proposed 2014 meeting schedule was satisfactory, but that early June may be preferable to mid- or late-June.
- 12. Carl Hansen noted that the Authority would be investigating the 12 November 2013 automatic underfrequency load shedding event and reporting will be made available to the SRC.
- 13. Dennis Barnes expressed an interest in further investigation of the 5 December 2013 grid emergency, with particular reference to whether it (when combined with expiring gas contracts) highlights any system risks of inadequate capacity or availability of thermal generation.
- 14. Dennis Barnes also suggested that Transpower's Chief Executive-in-waiting, Alison Andrews, should be invited to meet with the SRC.
- 15. Carl Hansen noted that—due to the cancellation of the October meeting—the SRC has breached the Electricity Industry Act 2010 requirement to meet "at least once every 6 months". The Chair asked the secretariat to relay to the Authority Board that:
 - there were no matters that the SRC did not consider in a timely manner
 - having only eight members raised the effective quorum requirement to 75% and that this requirement should be relaxed.
