Subject Second reminder: Closure of the electricity registry FTP

For your action

As you are aware, the Authority has been modernising and updating the communication channels between participants and the registry.

In 2010, the Authority released a consultation paper on moving these data interactions to a more secure type of transmission channel. After submissions were reviewed, the Authority agreed to implement Secure File Transfer Protocol (SFTP).

Web services, the EIEP Exchange hub, and registry data file interchange using Secure File Transfer Protocol (SFTP) are already fully operational and in use by many participants.

In November 2013 all existing participants were advised that the Authority will be closing FTP from 31 December 2014.

Action required

The registry has advised us that your organisation is using SFTP for some interactions but is still using FTP as well.

If your company is responsible for multiple participant identifiers please ensure that all of the participant identifiers have converted to SFTP.

Please ensure that you have fully transferred all registry interactions to SFTP by **31 December 2014**.
