Review of secondary networks

Recommendations

- 1. It is recommended the Retail Advisory Group (RAG):
 - (a) **approve** the issues and options paper, *Review of secondary networks: issues and options paper* (attached at Appendix A)
 - (b) **delegate** authority to the chair to finalise the paper in response to feedback from the RAG.

Rationale

- 2. At its meeting on 9 December 2014 the RAG members requested the secretariat to provide a revised issues and options paper at its 12 February 2015 meeting.
- 3. The RAG members asked that the following information be included in the revised paper:
 - (a) the customer impacts of the existing arrangements, including reliability and value
 - (b) the contrast between the responsibilities and obligations of local network owners and secondary network owners
 - (c) the costs and benefits of options, including rationalising the number of types of secondary networks.

Process

- 4. The issues and options paper describes the circumstances and issues relating to secondary networks: customer networks; embedded networks; and network extensions.
- 5. The paper includes:
 - (a) Analysis of the current arrangements, including the effect on the consumer of the efficiency and reliability of secondary networks
 - (b) A contrast between the responsibilities and obligations of local network owners and secondary network owners
 - (c) An assessment of benefits and costs, including rationalising the number of types of secondary networks

Next steps

- 6. The next steps are:
 - (a) the paper will be finalised and presented to the Authority Board for feedback

(b) the paper will be released for consultation after taking into account any feedback from the Authority Board.
