

Report on market operation service providers' compliance

June 2018

This report includes:

Self-reported breaches by the pricing manager (under clause 13.213 of the Code)

There were no self-reported breaches by the pricing manager.

Self-reported breaches by the clearing manager (under clause 14.68 of the Code)

There were no self-reported breaches by the clearing manager.

Self-reported breaches by the reconciliation manager (under clause 15.30(1) of the Code)

The reconciliation manager has breached Clause 15.14 (3) of the Code due to incomplete information because of a participant breach.

Self-reported breaches by the FTR manager (Not required by the Code)

There were no self-reported breaches by the FTR manager.

Self-reported breaches by the registry manager (Not required by the Code)

There were no self-reported breaches by the registry manager.

Self-reported breaches by the system operator (under clause 3.14)

Two breaches were reported in May by the system operator. The first relates to a change to offer which was not acknowledged correctly and was not then used in the forward looking schedules, this error reached real time causing a market impact of less than \$500. The second relates to a modelling error that removed a generator's offers from the forward looking schedules, this was identified before real time and corrected before dispatch.
