
## **Details of Variation**

The Authority would like to amend the Consultancy Services Order to allow the Provider to deliver Step 3 of the CBA Preparation Services for the Transmission Pricing Methodology Review, at follows:

- (a) insert, after clause 2.5) of the CSO:
  - "2.6) Following the methodology and the scope approved in full 12.7g, 1.6(b) for Step 2, for Step 3 the Provider will complete the CBA on the TPM guidelines proposal, and associated Code amendments. When completing the CBA the Provider will consider any feedback from Authority staff (including any external peer review commissioned by the Authority) and subject the CBA to the Provider's own quality assurance processes.
    - 2.7) The CBA must include:
      - (a) the CBA produced in Word
      - (b) a spreadsheet in Excel with a consolidation of the modelling results and list of the data used and the assumptions made
      - (d) the data files used as inputs
      - (e) other files showing the modelling code and results that are necessary to show how the Provider produced the CBA results.
  - 2.8) Deliverables and deadlines:
    - (a) The Provider will deliver the following deliverables to the Authority by the deadlines specified in the table below, for Authority staff to review.
    - (b) At thority staff will be available to respond to the Provider's questions during Step 3 of the CBA Preparation Services for the Transmission Pricing Methodology Review.
    - Authority staff will review and provide feedback on each interim deliverable (including any peer review) within 5 working days of receipt of the deliverable from the Provider.
    - (d) The deadlines for deliverables 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 9 are dependent on the Provider receiving information by a third party by 14 January 2019; if the information is received earlier or later the Provider will negotiate different deadlines with the Authority.
