Electricity Price Review: A review of security and resilience

- 1. The Authority is considering resourcing options for the review of security and resilience
- 1.1. As noted in a <u>24 October 2019 paper</u> to the SRC, the Government recommended a review of the security and resilience of the electricity industry.
- 1.2. Since then, the Minister of Energy and Resources wrote to the Electricity Authority formally setting out expectations for recommendations arising from the Electricity Price Review.¹ The letter noted that the review of security and resilience is in scope for the Authority. No further detail or guidance was noted.
- 1.3. The Authority has assessed resourcing options for meeting the Minister's expectations. Authority staff will attend the 12 March 2020 SRC meeting to:
 - a) give the SRC oral advice about the resourcing options under consideration and the possible implications for timing of the security and resilience review
 - b) answer any questions from the SRC.
