1. Background

The Electricity Commission has agreed to sponsor a workshop on 'Customer Participation through Load Management' to provide a forum for business enterprises to discuss the issues surrounding load management, metering and other enablers for demand side involvement in the electricity market.

Recent surveys in the Auckland and North-Isthmus regions indicate that there is potential to introduce more demand-side initiatives. Such customer actions will have a valuable role especially if transmission and generation supply-side solutions are delayed. A small number of customers participating in the market reducing load during winter and summer peak periods could have major benefits for all consumers.

In particular, the workshop will be exploring institutional, ownership or regulatory barriers to efficient investment in technologies that will enable:

- a. Consumers to choose their level of involvement in responding to pricing related to load management (including clear and predictable signals to underscore the value of demand-side solutions); and
- b. The supply side of the market to develop innovative products that will meet consumers' needs while continuing to meet other existing institutional requirements (notably common quality and real time security of supply).

The objective of the workshop is to facilitate discussion between the demand-side and supply-side of the market to clearly understand some of the issues and barriers preventing progress with load management.
