Electricity Industry (Enforcement) Regulations 2010

The new Electricity Industry (Enforcement) Regulations 2010 come into force on 1 November 2010. These regulations replace parts 4 to 8 of the Electricity Governance Regulations 2003 to reflect changes made by the Electricity Industry Act 2010.

The regulations set out:

- procedures for the Authority and the Rulings Panel to deal with complaints about breaches by industry participants
 of the Electricity Industry Participation Code (Code); and
- procedures for the Rulings Panel to deal with particular kinds of disputes between industry participants that relate to the Code; and
- provisions relating to the membership and operation of the Rulings Panel.
