## Electricity Governance Regulations (Exemption No. 40 (Pricing Manager)) Exemption Amendment Notice 2010

Pursuant to Regulation 196 of the Electricity Governance Regulations 2003, the Electricity Commission gives the following notice.

## Notice

- **1. Title and commencement**—(1) This notice is the Electricity Governance Regulations (Exemption No. 40 (Pricing Manager)) Exemption Amendment Notice 2010.
- (2) In this notice, the Electricity Governance Regulations (Exemption No. 40 Pricing Manager)) Exemption Notice 2007\* is called the "principal notice".
- (3) This notice comes into force on 1 April 2010.
- **2.** Amendment to principal notice—(1) The principal notice provides an exemption from some of the requirements to comply with Rules 4.2, 5.4(e) and 5.5 of Schedule G6 of Part G of the Electricity Governance Rules 2003.
- (2) The principal notice is amended by omitting the date on which the exemption is stated to expire (31 March 2010) and substituting **31 December 2010**.
- **3. Reasons for amendment**—The reasons for this amendment are:
  - (a) the existing exemption has ensured that in setting prices, the Pricing Manager has operated with clarity and consistency;
  - (b) the existing exemption has ensured that the Pricing Manager has used the most appropriate instantaneous reserves information in the pricing process; and
  - (c) extending the exemption will allow time for a rule revision to be implemented.
